NEWS FROM OUR SCHOOL

We have had a wonderful **Health and Wellbeing week.** Many thanks to Mrs MacCrory for organising the events and a big thank you to all our visitors for leading wonderful sessions across the week. Thank you to our parents for making our first Sports Day in three years a huge success. The children and spectators made it a wonderful day. Particular thanks to our EYFS parents who braved the rain in the afternoon and understood when rain stopped play, we hope you enjoyed the races we managed to squeeze in!

Social Media – A polite reminder that when Parents are in school watching events and taking photos (such as Sports Day) that they ensure the photos remain for personal use and treasured memories and are not shared on any social media platform if they contain images of other children from school. We do not have consent for all children to be on social media and sometimes this can be due to child protection. We do not want to be in a position where we cannot allow photos to be taken as we know how important they are, we just ask that you respect the social media policy.

Meet the teacher day - Wednesday 6th July

As you will be aware that as part of our transition arrangements, children will spend time with their new teacher on Wednesday. Please note that pick up and drop off arrangements will be the same for children for Years 1 - Year 6. Current Reception children spending time in Year 1 will be met on the playground by Mrs Cunningham and Mrs Harman, their new teacher and escorted to their new classroom.

Building Update –A polite reminder that Children should not be left unsupervised outside of the main reception before the doors open at 8.45am. We appreciate that some of our older children walk to school but if you could ensure they are not arriving too early. The front of school is now very busy and it is adjacent to the car park road. Children are continuing to arrive early, many unsupervised, playing chasing games and ball games, making it unsafe. Please support us by supervising your child until 8.45 am.

Staff Car park – Thank you to those parents who are now parking outside of the staff car park to drop off and pick up from link club – this is really helpful. Please could we ask for the small minority who are not doing so to begin to use the lay by on Stansfield Drive and avoid the staff car park at all times during the building works. Those displaying a valid blue badge are obviously welcome to continue to use the car park. We are just trying to manage an increase in the volume of traffic at peak times and keep it as safe as possible for all concerned.

School meals/snacks accounts - ParentPay

As we reach the end of the school year, please could we ask that you check your child's account and ensure that the account is in credit before the end of the year. We have a number of children's accounts in debt currently. May we remind parents/carers that the maximum amount outstanding should be no more than -£12, anything above this then we ask parents to send their child into school with a packed lunch and their own snack from home until the debt is cleared.

Year 6 parents, please ensure that ParentPay account is in credit before the end of the school year.

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Reception parents – You will be sent a ParentMail and an activation letter, for those who have not already set up a ParentPay account, this will be for your child in Year 1 as snacks will then be charged via ParentPay. **Year 2 parents** – please note that from Year 3, all meals and snacks taken at school are charged via ParentPay and your child's account will need to have enough credit to cover meals and snacks taken from September onwards.
